



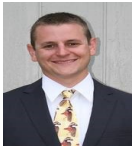

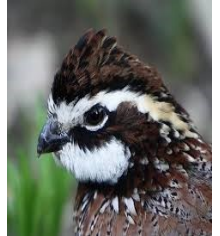


**Eric Grahmann, Ph.D., Director, Game Bird Science Program,

**Update on Past and Present Bobwhite and Scaled Quail Research**

### Projects Across South Texas

Eric Grahmann is Director of the Game Bird Science Program at the Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute. He was born and raised in Victoria Texas. While spending time with his father and grandfather on their family properties throughout south Texas, Eric developed his love for the outdoors, especially cattle ranching and the ranching culture, native rangeland, and wildlife (**most importantly quail**). Eric graduated from Sam Houston State University with a B.S. in Agriculture (2006) and a minor in science. He graduated from Texas A&M University-Kingsville with an M.S. degree in rangeland and wildlife management (2009) and a Ph.D. in wildlife science (2013) with minors in statistics.

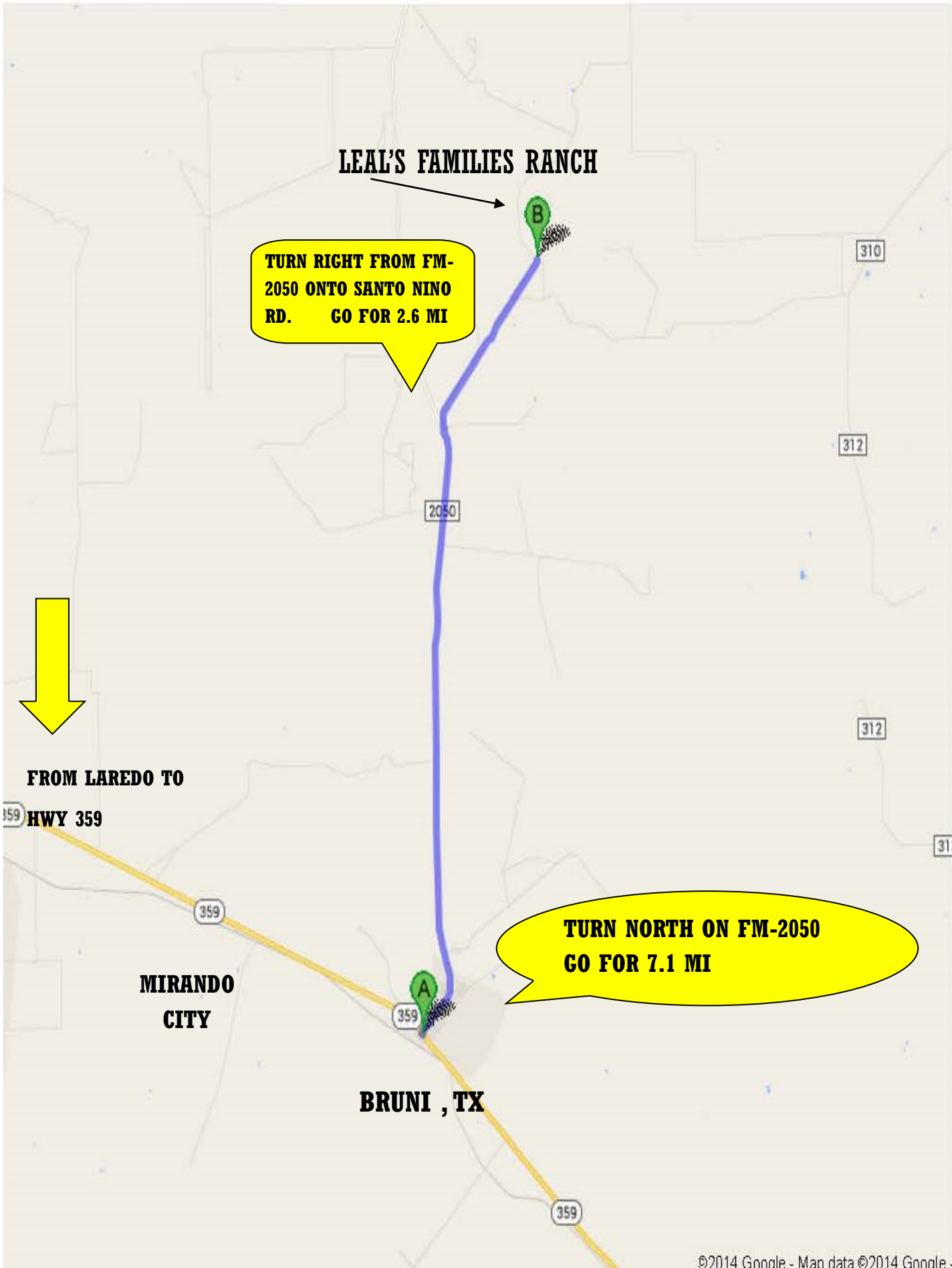
